- 5) How could one’s conscience be defiled by eating food that had been offered to an idol?
- 6) In verses 7-10:
 - a) Who is the one who “has knowledge?”
 - b) Who is the one who has not knowledge?
- 7) What precautions did the knowledgeable brother need to take with regard to eating food that had been offered to an idol?
 - a) How could a strong brother’s knowledge damage a weak brother’s faith?
 - b) What was the spiritual consequence for the knowledgeable brother? (That is, of what was he guilty?)
