- 4) The headcovering question is a difficult one: What changeable conditions affect the interpretation of these instructions?
- 5) What religious activities are discussed in the headcovering context?
- 6) Because of verse 15, what position do some take on the identity of the headcovering?
- 7) What were the Corinthians doing wrong with regard to the Lord's Supper?
- 8) According to verses 22 & 34, what was the proper sphere/place for eating *common meals (meals for satisfying hunger)*?
- 9) According to verses 20 & 33, what is the proper setting/circumstance for eating the Lord's Supper?
- 10) For what purpose is the Lord's supper observed?
- 11) What had happened to some Corinthians because of their unscriptural observance of the Lord's Supper?
