  - c. What are elders TO be and do"
- 4. Who is the Chief Shepherd?
- 5. What are younger people to do?
  - a. Who is to submit, and to whom, according to Ephesians 5:21?
- 6. *Thought Question:* Is the word "elders" in verse 5 used in the same sense that it is in verse 1?

- 14. To whom does Peter refer when he spoke of "she who is at Babylon?"
