1. Of the Christians scattered throughout the 5 provinces, which ones (or class) did he specifically address in verses 1-4?
2. What 3 descriptions did Peter give of himself in verse 1?
3. As did Paul in Acts 20:17, 28, what three terms did Peter use to describe elders?
 - a. Provide a brief description of each term:
 - b. What are elders NOT to be or do?
 - c. What are elders TO be and do?"
4. Who is *the Chief Shepherd*?
5. What are younger people to do?
 - a. *Who* is to submit, and *to whom*, according to Ephesians 5:21?
6. *Thought Question:* Is the word "elders" in verse 5 used in the same sense that it is in verse 1?

7. Who does God “exalt?”

8. What tool can we use to “cast our anxieties upon” God? (*hint: the topic was discussed back in 3:12*)

9. Why must Christians be sober-minded and watchful?

10. Peter tells us to “resist the devil.” In James 4:7, what did James say would happen as a result of doing this?

11. How extensive was the persecution of saints at the time of Peter’s writing?

12. What would God do for saints after they had suffered for a little while?
 - a. *Thought Question:* In verse 10, what did Peter mean by “a little while?”

13. Who carried this letter to the saints?

14. To whom does Peter refer when he spoke of “she who is at Babylon?”
