- 4) Along with Philippians 1:23, what use do some people make of verses 6 & 8 of this chapter with respect to what happens to people after death?
- 5) What event is described in verse 10?
- 6) What motivation does Paul give for persuading others? (11)
- 7) What did Paul want the Corinthians to “be able” to do according to verse 12?
- 8) From verse 13, what accusation had apparently been made against Paul and his companions?
- 9) What reason did Paul *here* give (15) as to why Christ died?
- 10) In what respect did Paul say that he no longer judged or regarded anyone?
 - a) Thought Question: Explain the significance of this in view of what is discussed in chapter 3:
- 11) What is an “ambassador,” and why were the apostles considered such?
