- b) What principle of giving is taught in 2 Samuel 24:24?
- 6) From verses 12 &13, what benefits and results came from the benevolent work that was performed by the Macedonian and Corinthian churches?
- 7) Thought Question: Verse 13 is a favorite passage of institutionalists who claim that the phrase "them and all [men]" means "saints and nonsaints." How does the passage itself answer the argument? (hint: what did people give in response to their gift?)
