  - b) Explain the timing of Revelation 19:6-9 on this point:
- 4) What tactic did Satan use to deceive Eve?
- 5) Though they rejected Paul, what things (doctrinal views) did some Corinthians accept and tolerate in other teachers? (*vs. 4, & 20, 21 for help*)
  - a) What was wrong about this inconsistency? (Of what sin were they guilty?)
- 6) What is suggested in the following verses about various accusations that were made against Paul:
  - a) Verse 5?
  - b) Verse 6?

- c) Verses 7-9?
  - d) Verse 11?
  - e) Verse 21?
- 7) What reason did Paul give for *not* taking preaching support from Corinth?
- 8) What *pattern* is given in verse 8 for the method that churches should use in supporting preachers?
- a) How is this reinforced by Philippians 4:15-16?
- 9) From verses 13-15, what do we learn about how Satan works?
- 10) Why did Paul list his sufferings? (similar to 6e above)
- 11) In what things did Paul say he would glory?
- a) What did he say about “glorying” in 2 Cor. **10:17**?
- 12) What principle of self-protection is taught in this chapter?
