- 6) Why and by whom were the Thessalonians “troubled?” (hint: v. 4)
- 7) 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18 and 2 Thessalonians 1:10 describe the implications of the Lord’s return with respect to *saints*: Who else will be affected, according to verses 8 and 9 of *this* chapter?
 - a) What will happen to them?
 - b) Thought Question: Contrasting the last part of 1 Thess. 4:17 with 2 Thess. 1:9, what is the greatest consequence of being lost?
