6. Describe Diotrephes:
 - a. What should saints do with such people as Diotrephes? *(for additional help see Ephesians 5:11; Titus 3:10-11; Romans 16:17)*
 - b. Whose character is contrasted with that of Diotrephes?
7. As he did to the elect lady of 2 John, what does John say to Gaius with respect to communicating with him?
