- 1) How are the events of this chapter significant in the overall scheme of redemption? (*Hint: Acts 11:18; Ephesians 3:6, 8*)
- 2) How did the Jews at Jerusalem initially react to Peter's actions among the Gentiles? (*Hint: Acts 11:1-3*)
- 3) Concerning Cornelius:
  - a. What does the title "centurion" suggest about Cornelius' position as a person and a soldier?
  - b. List some of the qualities that Cornelius possessed *before* his conversion: (*Hint: Acts 10:2, 22*)
  - c. Regardless of these qualities, what was Cornelius' *spiritual* condition at that time? (*Hint: Acts 11:14*)
- 4) What did the angel tell Cornelius to do?
- 5) Describe Peter's vision:
  - a. What "truth" did Peter learn from the vision? (34, 35)
  - b. *How* was this truth expressed/learned?
- 6) What did Cornelius attempt to do when Peter arrived? What other apostle was treated this way in the book of Acts? (*Hint: Acts 14:12-14*)
- 7) What does verse 33 suggest about Cornelius' attitude?
- 8) What happened to Cornelius while Peter yet spoke?
- 9) What prophecy that was quoted by Peter in Acts 2, is fulfilled in this chapter?
