- 3) Who was killed? Who did the persecutor intend next to kill?
- 4) What 2 miracles are recorded in Acts 12?
- 5) Describe the security details and conditions of Peter's imprisonment:
- 6) What did God do for Peter after he was imprisoned?
 - a. At what point did Peter realize that God had done this for him?
 - b. To what house did Peter then go?
 - c. What had the people at that house been doing for Peter?
 - d. What interesting/humorous thing occurred when Rhoda greeted Peter?
- 7) What happened to the prison guards who were on duty during Peter's escape? How does this help to explain the actions of the Philippian jailor in Acts 16:27?
- 8) How did the people react to Herod's speech? What did God do to him, and why?
- 9) Who did Barnabas and Saul take with them when they returned from Jerusalem, and what trouble later came from this? (*Hint: see 13:13 with 15:37, 38*)
