- 2) What two “Antiochs” are referenced in this chapter?
- 3) Is there a difference between “prophets” and “teachers?”
- 4) From what happened in verses 1-4, what do we learn about *God’s* view of the purpose and work of the local church?
 - a. Does 1 Timothy 3:15 relate to Acts 13:1-4?
- 5) What sorcerer is mentioned in this chapter? What did he try to do, and how was he punished?
- 6) What pattern do we see in this chapter with respect to Paul’s system of preaching once he arrived at a new place? (*Hint – Acts 17:2*)
- 7) What is said about John Mark in this chapter? How did his actions later affect Paul’s relationship with Barnabas? (*Hint – Acts 15:38-40*)
- 8) Paul’s Sermon:
 - a. How did Paul acquire the opportunity to speak?
 - b. What two groups of people comprised Paul’s audience? (*Hint – vs. 42*)
 - c. What key historical circumstances did Paul address?
 - d. What earlier Acts sermon is resembled in Acts 13:30-38?
 - e. How did the Gentiles react to Paul’s quoting of Isaiah 49:6?
 - f. How did the Jews respond, per verses 45 & 50?
