- 3) What two practices are identified with "receiving the Holy Spirit?"
- 4) For what purpose were these disciples rebaptized? (*Hint: compare Acts 19:5 with Acts 2:38*)
- 5) Verse 9 speaks of "the Way." What does this have reference to?
- 6) Why did Paul have to leave the Synagogue, and what facility did he and other disciples then use for study and teaching?
- 7) How long did Paul stay in Asia and how effective was he?
- 8) What "special" miracles did God perform through Paul?
- 9) What did the "exorcist" Jews do, and what was the result?
- 10) What books were gathered and burned?
- 11) Why were Demetrius and his fellow craftsmen upset with Paul?
 - a. What did the crowd do for 2 hours?
 - b. With what special task did the Ephesians believe they were entrusted, and why?
 - c. Why was the town clerk concerned about the uproar?
- 12) The word "ekklesia," which is usually translated "church," is used in Acts 19:39 to describe a legal assembly. What does this usage tell us about the word ekklesia?
