- 4) Before his conversion, what was Paul convinced that he ought to do to saints? Paul had told the council that he acted in good conscience (Acts 23:1). What does this tell us about the conscience?
- 5) What did Jesus tell Paul that He was sending him to do?
- 6) What reason did Paul give for the Jews seizing him?
- 7) How did Paul describe his teaching as it related to the Law of Moses? How does this conflict with what the Jews had accused him?
- 8) How did Festus react to Paul's defense? How does this reaction fit with Festus' actions in Acts 25:9?
- 9) What did Paul say about Agrippa's view of the prophets? How did Agrippa respond to the invitation? What does Acts 26:28 suggest about the use of the word "Christian?"
- 10) Why didn't Agrippa release Paul? Was his reason valid?
