 - b. What did the natives assume about Paul when they witnessed this?
 - c. What did the natives assume about Paul when they saw that no harm came from the incident?
- 3) Who was "Publius," and what happened with respect to his father?
 - a. What did this lead to with regard to other diseased people?
- 4) Where did Paul and the others find "brethren?"
- 5) What did Paul see that caused him to "thank God and take courage?"
- 6) To what place did Luke accompany Paul on this trip?
- 7) Describe Paul's living circumstances at Rome (2 verses speak to this):
- 8) What Jews visited Paul at Rome? Jews from *Jerusalem? Asia? Or elsewhere?*
 - a. What did these Jews know about Paul?
 - b. What did they know about the "sect" of Christ?
 - c. How many Jews were interested in this subject?

- d. How long did Paul meet with these Jews?
- 9) What reason does Paul give for having to appeal to Caesar?
- 10) What texts did Paul use in his effort to convince the Jews about Jesus?
- 11) What caused the unbelieving Jews to leave?
- 12) What did Paul tell the Jews that the Gentiles would do with regard to the gospel?
- 13) Luke cites two (general) topics that Paul proclaimed “with all boldness and without hindrance” - What were they?
