 - e. List the various expressions that indicate a <u>full</u> and <u>instantaneous</u> recovery by the lame man:
- 2) How did the people react to this healing? To where did they follow Peter?
- 3) Did Peter and John take credit for the healing? For what did Peter use this occasion?
- 4) From Acts 3:13-15, what is implied about who was guilty of murdering Christ?
- 5) What is meant by Peter's statement that the Jews killed Jesus out of "ignorance?" Compare 1 Corinthians 2:8:
- 6) Compare Acts 3:19 to 2:38 and 22:16: What expressions are used interchangeably?
- 7) To what Old Testament prophet is Jesus likened? What will happen to people who do not listen to Jesus? What is involved in *listening*?
- 8) What will be "the restoration of all things?" (v. 21)
- 9) What are the "times of refreshing from the presence of the Lord?" (v. 19)
