3. But if they looked, where would God not be found? (v. 5)
4. What had Israel done to justice and righteousness?
  - a. Amos later said what about these two qualities? (v. 24)
5. What was Israel’s attitude towards those who reproved them and spoke the truth to them? (10)
  - a. Paul warned Timothy that some Christians would develop the same attitude (2 Tim. 4:3-4). How would it be manifested?
6. What were Israel’s primary sins according to verses 10-12 and 21-23?
7. The “day of the Lord” would be \_\_\_\_\_ and not \_\_\_\_\_ (vs. 18 & 20)
8. What progression of increasing disasters did God cite to illustrate the futility of trying to escape His judgments? (v. 19)
9. Though God had *made* the stars (8), what did Israel do regarding them?
