1. Amos pronounced woe upon what people in verse 1?
  - a. According to that verse, what reasons did they have for “feeling” secure?
  - b. What similar warning did Jesus issue to disciples in Luke 6:26?
2. What three cities are cited in verse two and for what reason?
3. They put what “far away” and brought what “near?” (v. 3)
4. Verses 4-6 describe some of the particular reasons why Israel would be punished, but before addressing the specifics, give a brief one or two word description of their lifestyle:
  - a. What was significant about their beds?
  - b. What was significant about their food?
  - c. What was significant about their music?
5. What were they not “grieved” about? What is meant by this expression? (v. 6)

6. How would judgment affect these elitists in relation to the other sinners? (v. 7)
  
7. What did God “abhor” and “hate?” (8)
  
8. Verse 9 is reminiscent of Genesis 18:32, but what is the difference in Amos’ day with regard to how many would die from God’s judgment?
  
9. According to verse 10, what was the burier (or “burner”) of bodies to warn survivors against saying?
  - a. What does verse 11 suggest about a possible reason for this prohibition?
  
10. Israel’s perversion of justice and righteousness was as unnatural as horses running on and oxen plowing on \_\_\_\_\_. (12)
  
11. In what did Israel rejoice?
  
12. How widespread would be the oppression of the invading nation?
