Deuteronomy 10

- 1. What process did Moses describe in verses 1-5 and 10-11?
 - a. In what way was the 2nd set of Ten Commandments different from the first set? (see Exodus 32:16 & 34:1 for help)
 - b. *Thought question:* In typical Deuteronomy style, what actions did Moses condense and abbreviate in these first 5 verses?
 - c. How long was Moses on Sinai the second time?
 - d. What does verse 10 say that *the Lord* did during Moses' second stay on the mountain?
 - e. What had God *intended to do* with regard to the Israelites following the golden calf incident?
 - f. Why did this not happen?
- 2. Most Bibles have verses 6-9 set off by parenthesis and their placement in this passage is confusing to many Bible students. What explanation would you give for their placement here? (note: the answer to question 1f may have something to do with this)

- 3. Concerning the place of Aaron's death, how do we reconcile Numbers 20:27-28 with Deuteronomy 10:6?
 - a. Who was anointed priest in place of Aaron?
 - b. What jobs were the Levites to do?
 - c. Why didn't the Levites receive a land inheritance?
- 4. Why are verses 12 and 13 important, even today, even to New Testament Christians?
- 5. According to verse 15, why were the Jews privileged to conquer Canaan?
- 6. To what type of circumcision does Moses refer in verse 16?
 - a. How does Romans 2:28-29 relate to this requirement?
 - b. What is circumcision under Christ? (Colossians 2:11-12)
- 7. Why were Jews to be helpful to sojourners?
- 8. Deut. 10:20 (and 6:13) authorized "swearing by God's name." How does this harmonize with Matthew 6:33-37?
