1. What previous chapter does this one most resemble?
2. What attitude (and duty) to God does this chapter emphasize? (vs. 1, 13, 22)
 - a. Be prepared to explain the importance of this attitude in serving God:
 - b. How significant is this requirement according to Jesus? (Matt. 22:37-38)
 - c. According to Revelation 2:4-5, what had happened to the Ephesian church by the time of John's writing and what did they need to do?
3. Verses 2-7 of this chapter list some of the "great works and signs" that God had done for Israel:
 - a. Who saw them and who did not see them? (*remember Numbers 14:29-31 when answering the 1st part of this question*)
 - b. What examples of God's works are here cited?
4. What rewards are again cited for the Jews if they obeyed God? (8-9)
 - a. What benefit is cited in verse 23?
 - b. What benefit is cited in verse 25?

5. According to verses 10-12, what agricultural difference existed between the land of Egypt and the land of Canaan?

6. Considering verses 13-17:
 - a. What help would God provide the Jews if they were faithful to Him?

 - b. What would God do if they became unfaithful?

7. The teaching of verses 18-21 is restated from verses 6-9 of chapter 6. Why are these particular instructions so important?

8. What land description is given in this chapter?
 - a. Over what land did Solomon rule? (1 Kings 4:21)

 - b. What does Joshua 21:43 & 45 tell us about God's land promise?

9. What two things did God "set before" Israel? (verses 26-28)
 - a. What condition was attached to the blessing?

 - b. What two mountains were associated with the pronouncements of the blessing and the curse? Which for the blessing? Which for the curse?
