- 5. At the time of Moses's speaking in the book of Deuteronomy, how were the people conducting themselves according to verse 8?
 - a. When else did this happen? (hint: Judges 21:25)
- 6. Why were the Levites *not to be neglected*?
- 7. What reason is given *against eating blood*?
- 8. The food sections of this chapter teach that the Jews were to make a distinction between what two realms or areas of action?
- 9. How would the Jews be affected in their new land if they did what God required?
- 10.According to verse 31, how debased had the idolatrous practices of the Canaanites become?
