 - e. According to Numbers 9:10-11, what special provision was made for Passover observance?
- 4. The Passover memorial is closely connected to what other celebration?

- 5. What other word describes the "festival of weeks?"
 - a. How was this day determined? (see Leviticus 23:15-16)
 - b. Upon what day of the week was this day observed?
 - c. What significant thing later happened upon this day? (Acts 2:1-4 + 47 in some versions Acts 5:11 in others)
- 6. Leviticus 23:33-43 provides additional information on the festival of tents:
 - a. What did they do during that week?
 - b. What was the purpose of the celebration?
- 7. In the absence of Moses, what would the Jews need in Canaan? (18)
- 8. What two things pervert justice? (19)
- 9. What were the Jews not to plant in the land?
- 10. What were they not to set up?
