- 1. What was an Israelite to do if a brother's (neighbor's, countryman's) ox, sheep or donkey had wandered away from home?
  - a. What if the neighbor wasn't home?
- 2. What law was made about blurring sexual identity? (verse 5)
  - a. Due in large part to medical advancements, how far are people now going in violation of this principle?
- 3. What was forbidden in verses 6 & 7?
- 4. What things were not to be *mixed* or used together? (9-11)
- 5. What was to be done to a man who *falsely accused* his wife of being sexually promiscuous prior to his marrying her?
- 6. What was to be done to a woman who was sexually promiscuous prior to marriage?
- 7. What was the punishment for adultery?

## Notes & Questions On The Book of Deuteronomy

- 8. Several different scenarios are addressed regarding sexual relations in verses 23-29:
  - a. What was to be done in cases where a man had sexual relations with a betrothed woman who **did not** cry out for help?
  - b. What was to be done in cases where a man had sexual relations with a betrothed woman who **did** cry out for help, but no one could hear her? (case of forcible rape)
  - c. What was to be done in cases where a man had sexual relations with a **non-betrothed** woman?
    - a. What additional rule was made about divorce in such cases?
- 9. What is said about a man taking his father's wife?
  - a. What was additionally stated about this sin earlier in Leviticus 20:11?
  - b. *Thought question:* What case of this is discussed in the New Testament?
