 - a. Why weren't the Ammonites or Moabites permitted to enter the assembly?
 - b. For how long were they to be excluded and rejected?
- 2. Why were the Jews not to abhor Edomites or Egyptians?
 - a. When could people from these nations be permitted into the assembly?
- 3. Verses 9-14 address various scenarios of uncleanness, as discussed in Leviticus 11-15.
 - a. What circumstances typically associated with war might cause one to violate cleanliness laws?
 - b. What reason was given for burying human waste?

- 4. What law was given for the treatment of runaway slaves?
- 5. What was taught regarding prostitution and its fees?
 - a. *Thought question:* Why was this law needed in Canaan at that time?
- 6. What was said about charging interest on loans?
- 7. What law was given regarding vows?
- 8. What permissions and restrictions were given regarding eating from other people's vineyards and fields?
