- 3. Verses 5-10 discuss the "Levirate" marriage law:
  - a. Describe this procedure:
  - b. What was the widow to do if her brother-in-law refused to take his deceased brother's place as her husband?
  - c. If the brother continued to refuse his duty, how was his household stigmatized?
  - d. How did the Sadducees later attempt to use the levirate marriage law against Jesus? (Matthew 22:23-32)

- 4. In the case of two men fighting, what punishment was given for a wife who attempted to help her husband by seizing his opponent's private parts?
- 5. What law addressed weights and measures? (be prepared to explain how people could be cheated by this process)
- 6. What did God want done to the people of Amalek?
  - a. Why?
  - b. Who was eventually ordered to administer God's punishment of Amalek? (see 1 Samuel 15 for help)
  - c. What notorious failure occurred at that time?
