

Deuteronomy 26

1. What offering were the Jews to make when they came into the land?
 - a. Where was this offering to be made?
 - b. Before the priest took the offering, what acknowledgment were they to make?
 - c. After the priest took the offering, what story were they to recount? (vs. 5-9) *(feel free to abbreviate the story)*
 - d. Who was their “Aramean” (Syrian) “father,” and why was he called such?
2. Who was to be helped by the tithe of the third year? (verse 12 and 14:28-29)
3. As a part of their covenant agreement, the Jews were to declare certain things to God and He would declare things about them:
 - a. What were they to declare with reference to God’s commandments?
 - b. What were they to declare with regard to times of uncleanness?
 - c. What were they to declare with reference to “the dead?”
4. What would God then declare to the people?
