 - c. Why was Moses not allowed to enter Canaan?
- 2. Who would go before the Jews and fight their battles? (3, 6, 8)
 - a. What example did Moses cite as proof of this help?
 - b. What were the people (including Joshua) to <u>be</u> as a result of this special help and leadership? (6 & 7)
- 3. What was to be done during the feast of booths on every Jubilee year?
- 4. What prophecy is given in verses 16 and 17?
- 5. What was the purpose of the song that Moses was to write and teach to the people?
 - a. Where is this song recorded?
 - b. What special groups of people were assembled to hear it?
- 6. Where was the book of the Law of Moses to be stored? (not the stone tablets that were *in* the Ark, but the written scroll)
- 7. God had told Moses that the Jews would fall away, but upon what other basis did Moses know that the people would be rebellious after his death? (see 27)
