- 3. How did God help the Jews in the wilderness? (3-4)
  - a. How is the wilderness described in verse 15?
  - b. What dangerous things and conditions were there?
- 4. List the things that the Jews would acquire, enjoy and experience in the promised land: (7-10)

- 5. According to verses 11-14 & 17 what potential mental and attitudinal dangers would face the people after entering the promised land?
  - a. According to 1 Timothy 6:9, 10 & 17, what dangers are sometimes posed by wealth?
- 6. What would God do to the people if they forgot Him and stopped obeying Him?
  - a. What is cited as proof of God's willingness to carry out such a punishment?
  - b. What had Moses told them about this 40 years before? (see Leviticus 20:22-23)
