- 3) What items are made according to this chapter?
- 4) In the original instructions, which piece of furniture was described after the instructions for the incense altar? How is that different here?
- 5) What great balance is represented in the design and appearance of the Ark and its seat? (*hint: Consider what was in the Ark and what attribute of God the seat represented.*)
- 6) What were “staves” for?
- 7) What items are abbreviated in their description?
