

## Exodus 4

- 1) Of whom did Moses speak in verse one, when he said “they” would not believe him? (*hint: verses 28-31*)
- 2) What signs did God enable Moses to give as a proof to the people?
- 3) Which sign was later used with Pharaoh? What additional thing happened in connection with that miracle that is not discussed here?
- 4) One of these miracles was somewhat *related* to a later miracle: Which one?
- 5) What concern does Moses express regarding his own ability?
  - a. What is God’s answer to him?
  - b. What reservation had Moses earlier expressed? (3:11)
- 6) What request did Moses finally make that evoked God’s anger?
- 7) How did God provide for the (perceived) problem that Moses had?
  - a. What was Moses to Aaron? Aaron to Moses?
  - b. What lessons can we learn from Moses’ concerns and reservations?
- 8) What did Moses request of Jethro? Who went with Moses?
- 9) What would God do to Pharaoh’s heart? Explain, in view of 7:22; 8:15; 9:34:
- 10) The narrative is brief, but what can we infer happened at the inn (resting place), especially in view of Genesis 17:14?
- 11) What did God tell Aaron to do?
- 12) Why were the Jewish elders gathered together by Moses and Aaron?
