- 4) Because of Moses' request, of what did Pharaoh accuse the Jews of having too much?
- 5) Pharaoh assumed that the Jews were idle, and needed more to do:
 - a. How did the Egyptians view idleness?
 - b. What did he stop supplying to the workers, now requiring them to get it for themselves?
 - c. Was there a difference in the material, from what was supplied to what had to be gathered? (see verse 12)
 - d. How did this change affect their labor?
- 6) What did the Jews manufacture?
- 7) What did Pharaoh expect with respect to production rates, following his canceling of straw delivery?
- 8) Explain the difference between "taskmasters" and "officers:" (see 14-16 for help)
- 9) The last few verses of this chapter contain two examples of *complaining*:
 - a. To whom, and of what, did the officers complain?
 - b. To whom, and of what, did Moses complain?
