

Exodus 6

- 1) What did God tell Moses that he would now see with regard to Pharaoh? Why?
- 2) By what name had God *not been known* among the patriarchs? By what name *had He been known* among them? Explain the difference:
- 3) What covenant had God had in mind to fulfill through Moses?
- 4) What would be demonstrated to the Jews by God's bringing them out of Egypt?
- 5) Why didn't the children of Israel listen to Moses when he told them of God's plans for them?
- 6) What reason did Moses give to God as to why Pharaoh would not listen to him?
 - a. Romans 2:23-25 describes a similar situation: According to Paul, what affect did Jewish unfaithfulness have upon the Gentiles? How did their actions cause God to be viewed?
 - b. What practical lesson can be learned from this today?
- 7) What figure of speech did Moses use (twice in this chapter) to describe his "lips?" What is the significance of the phrase?
- 8) Though others are mentioned in the genealogy of verses 16-26:
 - a. What family is primarily discussed?
 - b. Moses and Aaron are emphasized in verses 26 and 27: Why?
 - c. This genealogy provides background for Korah's argument in Numbers 16: What did Korah and his followers do according to that chapter?
