- 1) List the three plagues recorded in this chapter:
- 2) What was the difference in what Moses did with frogs, and what the magicians did?
- 3) Were *all* of the frogs killed at the end of the plague?
 - a. What new problem developed from the frogs after they were killed?
- 4) Which plague could the magicians not replicate, and what conclusion did this force them to reach?
 - a. Did Pharaoh share their sentiments?
- 5) Which plague caused Pharaoh to ostensibly agree to let the people go into the wilderness to worship?
 - a. How far did Pharaoh initially agree to let the people go?
 - b. Why did Moses object to this plan?
- 6) What privilege (“honor” – NASB) did Moses give Pharaoh with regard to the removal of the frogs?
 - a. How is this similar to the way parents train small children with regard to obtaining things they want?
- 7) In the plague of flies, what did God do differently than before with respect to the geographical area that was affected?
 - a. Gesenius’ Lexicon says that these were probably “gad-flies:” How are they different from normal houseflies?
- 8) What was Pharaoh’s attitude towards Moses and God at the close of this chapter?
