- 1) List the plagues of this chapter:
- 2) The fifth plague was the *murrain*. What is “murrain,” and what did it affect?
 - a. In view of what is stated in verse 19, what must be meant by the statement in verse 6, that, “all the cattle of Egypt died?”
- 3) What distinction of cattle did God make with this plague?
- 4) Explain the significance of a “set time” for causing the murrain?
- 5) What did Moses sprinkle into the air to begin the sixth plague, and what plague did this produce?
 - a. What was affected by this plague?
 - b. Why didn’t the magicians try to replicate this plague?
- 6) The announcement of the seventh plague (hail) groups it with the other remaining plagues:
 - a. What would be targeted?
 - b. What would be proven?
 - c. What could God have already done to the Egyptians had He wanted to?
- 7) In what way was the hail unusual?
- 8) Exodus 11:5 states that cattle remained in the land of Egypt at the time of the tenth plague: What is said in verses 19 and 20 of *chapter 9* that explains how these cattle remained?
- 9) Which crops did the hail worse affect? Which were least affected?
- 10) What [insincere] confession did the hail cause Pharaoh to make?
