  - c. Explain why this memorial for Christians IS NOT “the Christian’s Passover,” as some affirm: (*for help see 1 Cor. 5:7*)
- 2) Which Egyptian plague was linked to the Passover?

  - a. The type of animal they were to use:
  - b. What the Jews were to do with the animal:
  - c. What else they were to eat with the animal:

- 4) What were the Jews to do with some of the blood of the animal?

- 6) What instructions did Pharaoh quickly give to Moses?
  - a. Explain the mood of Pharaoh and the other Egyptians with regard to the *timing* of the Jews' departure: (You might say that there was a sense of \_\_\_\_\_ ?) Why?
- 7) As had been promised in 3:22 and mentioned again in 11:2, 3, the Jews "spoiled" the Egyptians: Explain *what was done* and *why it was done*:

- 9) Where did they first go upon their departure from Egypt?
- 10) How many (men) departed from Egypt?
- 11) How many years did the Jews spend in Egypt?
- 12) Did the Jews obey God's Passover instructions?
