- 5) Explain what violation later occurred with respect to the transportation of the Ark: (*see 1 Chron. 13:7-10*)
 - a) How was this violation punished?
 - b) How was the violation corrected? (see 1 Chron. 15:11-15)
- 6) Explain the purpose of the "table" that was to be built:
