- 2) What did the people want Aaron to make, and why?
- 3) What did Aaron make, and what possible reason can be given for his choosing that particular form?
- 4) When questioned by Moses, how did Aaron explain what happened?
- 5) What was God's initial decision as to what to do with the people?
 - a) What changed His mind?
 - b) Another view is that God did not actually change His mind. Per this view, why did God say what He did to Moses?
- 6) Who reunites with Moses at some point in Moses' descent from the mountain?
- 7) What did Moses carry with him down the mountain, and what did he later do with them?
- 8) How did Joshua misinterpret the noise in the camp?
- 9) What was actually happening in the camp?
- 10) What did Moses do with the golden calf? What did he make the Israelites do with the remaining substance?
- 11) What were the faithful Levites to do, and what did this say about their character? How does this relate to the demand of Jesus in Matthew 10:35-37?
- 12) Who did Moses want God to blot out of his book as satisfaction for the sins of the Jews? What was God's response? What does this teach us about sin and responsibility?
