

Exodus 33

- 1) Beginning back in chapter 32, verse 34, and continuing into the first part of this chapter, where does God tell Moses and the people to go?
- 2) How would the angel help the people?
- 3) Contrasting verses 2 & 3 of this chapter with 23:21, explain the difference in the angels with respect to their identity:
 - a) What did God first say He would not do in connection with the journey?
 - b) Why would He not do so?
 - c) How did the people react to God's announcement?
- 4) What was "the tent (ohel) of meeting" of *this* chapter?
 - a) What tent (mishkan) had not yet been built? (not until chaps. 35-40)
 - b) What was the location of Moses' tent of meeting? How was this different than the place of the Tabernacle?
 - c) What signs indicated God's approval of Moses' tent?
 - d) What would later take the place of Moses' tent? (see 27:21)
- 5) Describe what happened in verses 12-17:
 - a) How did the outcome affect God's earlier stance of verse 3?
- 6) Being now emboldened, for what did Moses then ask?
- 7) What did God say would happen to one who saw His face?
- 8) How do you harmonize verse 20 with verse 11?
- 9) What of God was Moses allowed to see?
