## **Exodus 36**

- 1) What earlier chapter does this chapter parallel?
  - a) Explain the main *difference* between this chapter and that earlier chapter with respect to the <u>circumstances</u>:
- 2) Since the instructions for the Tabernacle and its furnishings were given earlier [chapters 25-31], why are we just now reading about their construction? That is, what interference had occurred?
- 3) What lesson can we learn from the exactness with which the previously given instructions are here implemented?
  - a) Exodus 39:43 describes the results of Moses' inspection of the work: What did his inspection reveal?
  - b) What does Deuteronomy 4:2 say *not* to do?
- 4) What interesting thing had to be done with respect to the people's *giving*?
  - a) What did this degree of enthusiasm in giving suggest about their commitment to the work?
  - b) How had their thinking changed since chapter 32 [the golden calf event]?
  - c) What must have brought about this change in their thinking?
- 5) Though the details [dimensions, materials...etc] are the same, the order of items changes:
  - a) Chapter 25 has the Ark of the Covenant first, but what is first in actual construction?
