- 1) How many generations are listed in this chapter?
- 2) What lineage is followed in this chapter?
- 3) What is the oldest age given? What is the shortest age given?
- 4) Are we told anything about why people lived so long prior to the flood?
- 5) Adam was formed *directly by God* in God's own likeness and image (Gen. 1:26, 27). Seth was conceived in Adam's "likeness and image" (Gen. 5:3). Is it accurate to describe modern conception and birth as "a miracle?"
- 6) What special honor was given to Enoch? Why?
 - a. What other person was given this honor? (*For help, see 2 Kings 2:10*)
 - b. From Amos 3:3, what is implied about Enoch by the fact that he "walked with God?"
 - c. What do we learn about Enoch from Jude 14 and 15?
- 7) Except for Enoch, what words are used to describe the end of each man in this chapter?
- 8) Contrast the seventh from Adam through Cain (Gen. 4:19) with the seventh from Adam through Seth (Gen. 5:22-24):
