- 1) What cataclysmic event does God announce in this chapter? Why did God cause this event? How did Peter rank this event? (2 Peter 3:5-7)
- 2) What other Genesis chapters go with this chapter's narrative?
- 3) Some have suggested that the "Nephilim" (giants, or possible "ferocious" men) were the result of fallen angels cohabiting with human women. However, the context suggests a more realistic explanation. Chapters 4 and 5 discussed the lineages of Cain (Cainites) and Seth (Sethites). Given this context, who were "the sons of God" and who were "the daughters of man?"
- 4) How great was man's "wickedness" upon the earth?
 - a. What does Luke 17:27 tell us about life conditions on earth at Noah's time?
- 5) How did man's wickedness affect God's attitude towards man?
- 6) How much time did God give man upon the earth?
- 7) Why did Noah find "favor" in God's sight?
 - a. How does Hebrews 11:7 describe Noah?
- 8) Describe the "ark:"
- 9) According to 2 Peter 2:5, what other job did Noah have along with building the ark?
- 10) To what salvation requirement does Peter compare Noah's salvation by the ark? (*Hint: 1 Pet. 3:20, 21*)
