

## Genesis 7

- 1) Why did God allow Noah and his family to go into the ark and escape death?
- 2) How many of each kind of clean animal went into the ark? How many of each of the unclean animals?
- 3) From Genesis 8:20, what can we learn about a possible reason for the number of *clean animals*?
- 4) What description is given of Noah in 6:22 and 7:5?
- 5) Some have questioned how Noah and 7 others could have gotten the animals and birds onto the ark: What does Genesis 2:19 say about how the animals came to Adam to be named?
- 6) What were the sources of water for the flood?
- 7) How does this chapter answer the question about whether the flood was *universal or local*?
  - a. What can we conclude from Genesis 9:11 with regard to the extent of the flood?
- 8) How long did it rain? How long did the flood waters prevail upon the earth?
- 9) How long were the people and animals in the ark? (*for help, see Gen. 7:11 with Gen. 8:13-15*)
