- 5) What did God do to accelerate the drying process?
- 6) Was the drying of the earth instantaneous?
- 7) What was the total amount of time that Noah spent on the ark? (*for help see 7:11 & 8:14*)
- 8) Cite the evidence that Noah discovered that led him to believe that the waters were receding:
- 9) What use did Noah make of birds?
- 10) Did Noah make his own decision about when to leave the ark?
- 11) What is the first thing that Noah did when he left the ark? Was he told to do this?
- 12) What promise did God make about mankind and the earth? How does this harmonize with 2 Peter 3:10?
