 - a. What was their purpose?

 - c. How were these visitors received by Lot?
- 2) What did the men of the city do when Lot received the visitors? What were their intentions towards the visitors?
- 3) Why did Lot offer his two virgin daughters to these men? Was this right for him to do?
 - a. This is the first of 3 things that Lot did that suggest that his convictions had been affected by his stay in Sodom: What are the other two things?
- 4) What did the angels do to the wicked men who surrounded Lot's house?
- 5) The city was to be destroyed "because the outcry against its people has become great." What is meant by this statement?
- 6) How did Lot's sons-in-law react to his warning?
- 7) What happened to Lot's wife? Why?
- 8) Where did Lot ask to stay upon his departure from Sodom? Did he continue there? Possible reason for his actions?
- 9) What did the Lord do to Sodom and Gomorrah? What did it look like to Abraham?
- 10) What did Lot's daughters do to Lot, and why?
- 11) This chapter contains two (possibly 3) examples of situation ethics: What are they?
