- 5) What question did Isaac ask of Abraham, and how did Abraham answer his question?
- 6) What is suggested by God's words, "Now I know that thou fearest God?"
- 7) After being stopped by the voice of the angel, what did Abraham see caught in the thicket, and what did he do with it?
- 8) What promise is renewed to Abraham?
- 9) According to verse 18 (as in 26:5), what had Abraham done that resulted in God's blessing?
- 10) What is the purpose of the information recorded in verses 20-24?
