  - d. What concern did Judah have for Shelah, and what lesson does this teach about the influence of godless mothers and wicked siblings?
  - e. What plans did Judah have for Shelah? This story proves that the Levirate law was practiced prior to the Law of Moses (Deut. 25:5-10): Explain the Levirate law:
  - f. For what purpose did the Sadducees cite the Levirate law (Matt. 22:23-28)?
- 3) Who was Tamar, and how did she deceive Judah?
  - a. Why did Tamar so deceive Judah?
  - b. When did Judah command to be done with Tamar once he discovered she was pregnant?
  - c. Upon learning the truth, what did Judah admit that suggested that Tamar's actions were more honorable than his?
- 4) What is said about Judah that implies repentance on his part?
