- 7) What does Pharaoh's reaction suggest about his attitude towards Joseph?
- 8) What land (district) of Egypt was given to the Jews?
- 9) How is this Pharaoh different from the one of Exodus 1?
- 10) What instruction did Joseph give to his brothers relating to *behavior* on their trip?
 - a. Based upon 42:21, 22, what possible reason might Joseph have had for giving this instruction?
- 11) How did Jacob react to the news that Joseph was alive?
- 12) What helped convince Jacob that the news was true?
