7. From 1 John 3:12, what was wrong with Cain's sacrifice?
8. Enoch was "translated." What does it mean to be "translated?"
9. What is *impossible to do* without faith?
10. What did Noah do *by faith*?

11. What did Abraham do *by faith*? (3 separate things are mentioned)

12. Genuine faith involves obedience, but what aspect of faith is emphasized in the examples of Isaac, Jacob and Joseph?

13. What did Moses do *by faith*?

14. Unlike Moses, men generally "esteem" material things to be more important than other things:

a. According to Luke 16:14-15, what did the Pharisees highly esteem?

b. According to Luke 12:15, what does a man's life **not consist of**?

c. Read 1 Tim. 6:10: What is the "love of" money? What do riches often cause?

d. Read 1 Timothy 6:17: What happens to the mind and attitude of a person who *loves* riches?
