3. In Matthew 2:15, what extended application is made of Hosea 11:1?
4. The more God "called" Israel (by His prophets), the more they did what? (2)
5. To where would Israel not return? Who *would* be their king? (v. 5)
 - A. This invading nation would be their king because why?
 - B. The sword would slash, devour and consume because why?
6. What were the people "bent" upon doing?
7. What *characteristic* of God is emphasized in verses 8 and 9?
 - A. God so _____ the world... (John 3:16)

- B.** God's _____ would still be executed against Ephraim, but not in its fiercest way. (v. 9)
- C.** What reason did God give for not reacting and punishing in an extreme way?
- 8.** *Thought question:* Why does God say that He would not “again” destroy Ephraim?
- 9.** Why are “Admah” and “Zeboiim” mentioned? (What was the history of these places?) (see Deuteronomy 29:23 for help)
- 10.** Verse 10 speaks of a time when Israel would “walk after” the Lord. Hosea had before spoken of such a time (3:4-5), but said also that “David” would be their king. David was long dead, but Who would later sit upon his throne? (Luke 1:32)
- 11.** Hosea also spoke of the Lord roaring like a lion. Who was the “lion of the tribe of Judah?” (Revelation 5:5)
- A.** Of what time did Micah refer when he spoke of walking in the Lord's paths? (Micah 4:2)
- 12.** At the time of Hosea's writing, what was the tribe of Judah still doing?
