

Questions On Hosea Chapter 3 (and 4)

1. Hosea was to again approach Gomer, but unlike in chapter one, where there was a question about her morals at the time he married her, **what was her situation this time?**
2. This small chapter contains some parallels relating to Hosea's relationship with Gomer and God's relationship with _____.
3. In the first parallel, Gomer and Israel were both guilty of adultery but explain the sense in which Israel was guilty: (v. 1)
4. What did Hosea pay to coax Gomer back to him?
 - A. Was Gomer willing, sincere and penitent at this point?
5. Verses 3 & 4 show another parallel. Be prepared to explain this parallel.
6. Like the end of the previous two chapters, the last verse of this chapter points to what future time?

Questions On Hosea Chapter 4

1. According to verse 1, what was *not* practiced in the land?
2. According to verse 2, what was practiced in the land?
3. How did these actions affect the land? (vs. 3 & 10)

4. What did the people “lack” according to verse 6, and what would be the result?
5. What classes of people are addressed in verses 5-9?
6. What resulted from wine consumption? (v. 11)
7. God’s people are supposed to inquire of Him, but to what things did Israel inquire? (12)
8. God’s people are supposed to sacrifice to Him and in His designated place, but where and to what did Israel sacrifice?
9. According to verse 15, who had not yet become unfaithful, and what did God want Israel to do regarding that people?
 - A. Verse 15 is a lesson about evil influence. What does 1 Corinthians 15:33 teach about this?
10. To what was Israel compared in verse 16?
11. Ephraim was joined to her _____.
12. Verse 18 cites the sad and shameful condition of Israel in Hosea’s time. When their drink ran out what did they do?
